LCMS President Pastor Matthew Harrison asks for members of LCMS churches to pray the Litany daily during Lent as a way to help improve our devotion times. His wording: "Left to ourselves, bereft of texts as the foundation of our prayers, we are often left praying "Dear God, give me a mini-bike," as I was wont to pray as a 12 year old – and am prone to pray even today! ... The fulsome petitions of the Litany take us out of ourselves, to pray for the church, pastors and teachers, our enemies, women with children, the poor, the imprisoned and much much more."
