About the Location and Lodging

The “Crowne Plaza Aire MSP Airport Mall of America” (3 Appletree Square, Bloomington; www.crowneplazaaire.com/location.php) is located just to the East of the Mall of America (MOA) in Bloomington, Minnesota, a southern suburb of Minneapolis, and is mere minutes South of the Mpls./St. Paul International Airport. From the North: I-35W South to I-494 East; to 34th Ave. Exit 1b. Turn right on 34th Ave., one block to American Blvd., turn left. Hotel entrance on right.

From the South: I-35W North to I-494 East; to 34th Ave. Exit 1b. Turn right on 34th Ave., one block to American Blvd. and turn left. Hotel entrance on right.

From the East: I-494 West to 34th Ave. Exit 1b. Turn left on 34th Ave. Go two blocks to American Blvd. and turn left. Hotel entrance on the right.

From the West: I-494 East to 34th Ave. Exit 1b. Turn right on 34th Ave. Go one block to American Blvd. and turn left. Hotel entrance on right.
